Overall very positive and stimulating.


Question 2



It makes it incredibly difficult to be two full time parents whilst also balancing wraparound care outside of the school hours.

Limited after school club so make sure that works for you.

The school organizes various activities throughout the year which brings the community together providing additional/alternative learning opportunities for kids.

Social experience

Rockmount is a very nurturing and caring school where all pupils seem very happy.

Our son is really enthused about the extra bits the school lays on. He always comes home excited about what's going on that week and is really engaged. He was very chuffed to be able to name one of the ducklings recently!

The activities really add up to the learning and social experience.

Unfortunately, there isn't great wrap around care, due to short staff or funding, I'm unsure.

I think it is a great and lovely school, the only thing to improve is the after school wrap up so it is available for everyone who needs it.

My daughter is in Reception and we couldn't be happier with our/her experience. She learns so much and you can tell how much heart and dedication her teachers put to create the perfect environment for learning and playing.

It's a lovely friendly school with a brilliant community.

School trips/experiences are excellent. After School Club and After School activities are harder to get than Glastonbury tickets, so I do mention that, as wrap around care is very important to lots of people. I know the school are working hard to sort this, but I do feel it's urgent.

Excellent extra-curricular activities/trips etc.

Not enough space in afterschool clubs.

Good clubs, brilliant winter and summer fares community activities and afterschool provision - but it is oversubscribed.

Summary

The responses were overwhelmingly positive:

64 positive comments (100%)

Question 2: Transition - How well did Rockmount support your child to settle into Nursery/Reception at Rockmount?

Average 1.6% (1 response)

Yes 100% (64 responses)

Question 4: Facilities and resources - How would you rate the quality of the facilities and outdoor spaces for EYFS children? (Scale: 5 Excellent and 1 Poor)

5 or 4 stars 98.5% (63 responses)

3 star 1.6% (1 response)

Average rating 4.67 – between star 4 and 5, so very positive.

Question 5: Overall satisfaction and recommendations - Would you recommend Rockmount's EYFS provision to other parents?

positive comments 96.9% (62 responses)

2 responses cited the need for increased wrap around care availability at the end of the school day or the tidiness of the outdoor area.

Question 6: Overall satisfaction and recommendations - As a parent/carer of a child in either Nursery and/or Reception, what would you want to tell a prospective parent/carer about the opportunities we have on offer beyond the classroom at Rockmount?

Comments were overwhelmingly positive.

16 did not comment

10 comments included the desire for an expansion in the availability of wrap around care provision at the end of the school day.

Actions in response to parent/carer comments

- An EYFS specific After School Club has been established in May to provide 32 places for Reception age children. This will be based in the Nursery rooms.
- Additional Activity Clubs have been introduced for the summer term including gardening, woodcraft, cooking x2, exploring clay and film club.
