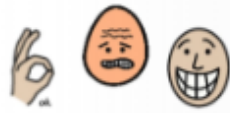

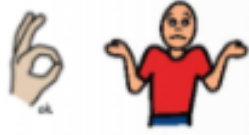

How do you feel about starting school?

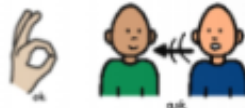
It is ok to feel nervous or excited. Everyone feels this way when they are starting something new.
