Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all enjoyed the Easter break and the improvement to the weather! The summer term is always a busy time and there are lots of events planned over the next few weeks.

We would like to thank everyone for their response to the school funding letter we sent out on March 18<sup>th</sup> – a copy of this is attached at the end of this letter. The positive comments passed to us about this at our parent/carer consultation evenings were very much appreciated by senior leaders. Thank you to those families who have already contributed by a monthly payment or an annual payment – all contributions support us in providing the additional opportunities for our children.

Many parents and carers took time to complete the questionnaire during the parent/carer consultation appointments last month. We are grateful for the feedback we received and we are using this to plan some further parent/carer workshops and information sharing opportunities so that we meet the needs of the school community. Webinars, as well as in person workshops, will be facilitated to address the requests for more accessible timings. Webinars planned for the summer term include Oracy and Talk Rich Learning. This is a key focus for us in school as we are making excellent progress in our partnership with Oracy Cambridge and are hoping to receive a prestigious formal accreditation from them by the end of the summer term. Understanding the school curriculum and supporting maths at home were also areas suggested through the questionnaire. Details on workshops and webinars will be circulated shortly.

Rockmount Friends and Community (RFC) have been very busy supporting the school community to raise funds to support projects in school. We are very pleased that a wonderful new sound system has been installed in the main hall during the Easter Break which has been fully funded by RFC funds. This will support school performances, workshops and assemblies but, most importantly, it will help to build pupil confidence in presentation, speaking aloud and performance. Many thanks to all of you who support the fundraising cake sales, film nights, discos, fairs etc!

We are now looking forward to the RFC BINGO evening on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7.45pm. It's sure to be an enjoyable evening for parents/carers and staff whilst raising funds for the RFC's future projects – all welcome to join in!

Dear Parents and Carers,

The sustained success of Rockmount Primary is heavily founded on the strong partnership between home and school and your ongoing support as parents and carers. As many of you will be aware, schools across the UK are facing tight budgets due to the current economic climate.

A school fund is a separate pot of money to the budget provided by the government. It is used to enhance educational experiences and resources, providing important opportunities for students that they would not otherwise have access to.

At Rockmount Primary we use our school fund for activities, equipment, specialist workshops and resources, all of which enrich the pupils' learning and school experience and which we are not necessarily able to fund from the budget provided by the government.

Perhaps even more importantly, we use the fund to ensure that students from families facing financial hardship can fully participate in all aspects of school life. We know that this broader engagement greatly enhances their sense of belonging, enjoyment of school and long-term outcomes. Support may include subsidised or fully funded music and drama lessons, enrichment trips, uniform grants and other essential opportunities.

Please note that the school fund does not pay for day-to-day running costs, staff salaries, or any part of the core curriculum.

In the past year we have had several families approach the school expressing a wish to contribute to the school fund and we are extremely grateful that a number of parents/carers already make regular, as well as one-off contributions.

We are now inviting the wider community to consider contributing to the Rockmount School Fund. This idea was discussed last year at a Parent/Carer Forum Meeting and with our Governing Board where it was noted that many families may want to support the school through either annual or monthly donations.

We are suggesting a voluntary contribution of £8 per month (a total of £96 per year) through a standing order or as a one-off payment. Please feel free to give more or less depending on your circumstances. Any amount is appreciated and will be carefully put to use supporting our pupils' extended learning experiences in school.

We completely understand that some families may not be in a position to contribute, and we want to reassure you that this is absolutely fine; not contributing will have no adverse impact. We also understand that many families may be experiencing financial hardship, please remember we are here to help and support you.
