

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This half term nursery will be learning how to share and take turns. We will also talk about our feelings and understand how others might be feeling.

Communication & Language

The children will be using talk to organise their play, especially in the role play area. E.g. "Let's go on the bus...you sit there...I'll be the driver...Where do you want to go?"

Physical Development

We will be focusing on developing the children's fine motor skills, using one handed tools and equipment safely and with accuracy.

Nursery – Spring 1 Passport Around the World

Silver Class will be focusing on transport and travelling around London on our role play 450 bus, with Paddington Bear. We will then travel around the world on different forms of transport, using the world map to guide us.

We are developing speaking and listening skills, enriching vocabulary and encouraging effective communication. We aim to foster a love of books and an interest in sharing stories. In particular, we will focus on a range of transport related books, including, 'The Boat Race' by Jane Hissey and 'Oi! Get off our Train', by John Burningham.

The children will learn to count accurately and to order and recognise numerals. They will also learn about size, shape and pattern.

We will investigate and experiment with a wide range of materials and resources and learn to describe and discuss what we see and discover. We will also explore colour and texture and will build and construct models in our creative workshop area.

Enrichment:

Exploring the changes spring brings in our school grounds

Maths

The children will develop fast recognition of up to 5 objects without counting (subitising) and compare quantities using the language, 'more than' and 'fewer than'.
