Autumn is all around

Autumn term

The second half of the autumn term will focus on a variety of themes incorporating festivals and celebrations which occur at this time of year.

We will be looking at seasonal changes as well as learning about some animals, such as foxes, hedgehogs and badgers. We will talk about nocturnal animals and hibernation.

We will begin to focus on a range of the children's favourite and well-known stories, such as, 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson, 'The Nutty Nut Chase' by Kathryn White and 'Elmer's Christmas' by David McKee. The environment will be planned to include activities linked to these key stories. For example, in the 'small world' area, the children will be able to re-tell the stories and play with props from the story.

Our focus on mark making will continue and we will encourage the children to talk about what they have written, drawn or created. We will also do lots of counting using a wide variety of resources and activities.
