Getting to Know Each Other

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

The children will be learning all about each other and exploring their new environment.

Communication & Language

The children will be supported to extend their vocabulary through familiar stories and nursery rhymes.

Physical Development

The children will be developing their fine motor skills, including how to hold pencils and use scissors.

Welcome to Nursery

This half term the main focus will be settling into the new environment and getting to know each other. We will support the children to form positive relationships and have fun together.

We will ensure that the children are comfortable in their surroundings and encourage them to explore and experiment with a wide range of exciting new activities.

We will begin to focus on a range of the children's favourite and well-known stories, such as, 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr. Many of the areas of learning will encompass aspects of these stories. For example, in the 'workshop' area, we will make masks and puppets to use in the role play area when acting out the stories we have read.

We will also be encouraging effective communication and supporting the development of speaking and listening skills through discussion during child and adult led play-based activities.

The children will also learn to count, order numbers, recognise numerals and develop their fine motor skills, including how to hold pencils and use scissors.
