How has crime and punishment changed throughout the ages?

This half term, our overarching theme focuses on Crime and Punishment. We will be learning all about Crime and Punishment through the ages, starting with the Romans. This leads on from our topic of The Victorians, as we also look at Crime and Punishment during that era. To support the learning, our key text is Wild Boy by Rob Lloyd Jones. The children will read extracts from the story. It is set during the Victorian Times and follows a crime that was committed. We will be using the text to write a back-story on one of the characters, using our inference and deduction skills to predict and write the next chapter and writing a formal letter from the perspective of a character in the story. We will explore the crimes which were committed and the different punishments they experienced, drawing on comparisons to how it is now. We will be designing and making our own model guillotines! Also, look out for some amazing Buddhism sculptures, following an art journey in our sketch books.
