This half term, our topic in Year 3 is 'What makes the earth angry?'. Our class text is 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit and we will be learning how to write our own action-packed disaster stories. We will be looking at how we can create atmospheric stories filled with descriptive language. We are also writing poems linked to volcanoes and will be exploring how to add alliteration, onomatopoeia and similes.

In the wider curriculum, we will be designing and making our own working models of volcanoes. We will be learning about how they are formed and why people choose to live near them. We will also be learning about the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the history of Pompeii.
