In History, we will learn about famous nurses such as Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale, discovering how nursing has changed over the years.

In Literacy, we will be writing super sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will sequence and retell familiar stories, adding our own creative ideas and descriptive vocabulary. We will be reading lots of stories such as 'Leaf Man' by Lois Ehlert and 'Hoorah for Mary Seacole'.

In Art, the children will experiment with using different tools to draw a self-portrait. In computing, we will improve our understanding of algorithms and video recording by becoming TV chefs.
