Year 6 – Spring 1

North America

This half term, our overarching theme focuses on North America. We will be exploring North America, looking at famous landmarks that represent a part of history. We will also be examining the vast physical and human geography of North America, looking at landscapes and drawing on comparisons and similarities to our own here in the U.K. Furthermore, we will be learning about the historical aspect of North America, reconnecting with its past, researching Native Americans and looking at land settlement.

In English, we will be reading a variety of Native American legends and then writing our own legend! We will also be writing travel brochures and looking at persuasive writing.

In Art, we are looking at American Gothic art by Grant Wood. The children will study this different style of art and then use these newly learnt skills to create a parody of Grant Wood's most famous art piece.

To support our science topic, we will head out to the edible playground and pond area and explore the wildlife we have here at school, looking at habitats!
