What is the cost of a natural disaster?

This half term, our overarching theme focuses on Natural Disasters. We will be exploring naturally caused phenomena that can have devastating effects on people who happen to live, or be around, the area affected. We will be learning about volcanoes, tsunamis, flooding, forest fires, tornados and hurricanes and the devastating effects they have on communities. Furthermore, we will be learning about the Earth's climate, extreme temperatures and weather conditions, that can lead to natural disasters. Our geographical enquiry will focus on the question 'What is the impact of natural disasters on the earth?' We will be learning about the true story of Tami Oldham, who survived 41 days adrift in the Pacific Ocean. We will read the book 'Survivors' and use these stories to support us with our writing. In DT, we will be designing and building bridges that can withstand windy weather. To summarise all the units this term, we will be visiting the Thames Barrier to look at how London protects the city from flooding.
